



## The 3<sup>rd</sup> International Conference on Fisheries and Aquaculture - 2016

## (ICFA 2016)

The 3<sup>rd</sup> International Conference on Fisheries and Aquaculture 2016 – (ICFA 2016) was organized by The International Institute of Knowledge Management (TIIKM), Sri Lanka in the collaborations with Asian Institute of Technology as the Academic Partner and The National Aquatic Resources Research and Development Agency (NARA), National Aquaculture Development Authority of Sri Lanka (NAQDA), INFOFISH, and Sri Lanka Convention Bureau as the Strategic Partners.
