With aquaculture projected to drive a 10% increase in production by 2032, ICFA 2025 will focus on optimizing production, strengthening value chains, and prioritizing small-scale fisheries, which contribute 40% of the global catch and sustain millions of livelihoods. By fostering collaboration, ICFA 2025 aims to deliver transformative outcomes that enhance aquatic ecosystems, ensure food security, and contribute to sustainable development worldwide.


